Some high-resolution monitors may have difficulty with the print resolution on the tax forms printed using Mag-Filer. There are a few options for resolving this issue.

- 1. Run compatibility troubleshooter from the Mag-Filer properties.
 - A. To access the utility, right-click on the Mag-Filer icon.
 - B. Select Properties.
 - C. Click the Compatibility tab.
 - D. Select the Override high DPI scaling behavior option, and Application in the dropdown selection box. If this option doesn't exist, then mark the Disable display scaling on high DPI settings option.
