

Storage and Service Schedules

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Storage and Service Schedules may be applied to Assemblies and Settlements. The schedules can be set up with the initial charges and/or daily rate charges.

Inactive

- **Charge ID** – Enter a code to identify the Storage/Service Charge. This code may be up to 20 characters in length.
- **Description** – Enter a description for the Storage/Service Charge. The description may be up to 20 characters.

Type

- **Storage** – Select if this charge is calculated on stored grain.
- **Service** – Select if this charge is calculated on contracts.
- **Initial Charge Rate** – This is a flat rate charge for a specific number of days or through a specific date.
- **Scale Ticket Charge Start Date** – Select from the following options to determine the *Start Date*:
 - *Each ticket is calculated separately*
 - *Selected Settlement Scale Tickets*
 - *All Scale Tickets on the Assembly*
- **Base Start Date on** – Select the option for the calculated *Start Date* for the Storage/Service Charges.

- **Average Scale Ticket Date** – This represents an average date of all Scale Tickets entered on an Assembly.
- **First Scale Ticket Date** – This represents the date of the first Scale Ticket entered on an Assembly.
- **Last Scale Ticket Date** – This represents the date of the last Scale Ticket entered on an Assembly.
- **First ST With Split Units** – Select this option to start charges based on first date of Scale Ticket split.
- **Last ST With Split Units** – Select this option to start charges based on last date of Scale Ticket split.
- **Through Date** – The *Initial Charge* is effective through this specified date.
- **Number of days covered** – Enter the number of days the *Initial Charge Rate* covers.
- **Use original start date when grace period expired** – If selected when the *Grace Period* is expired, the charge *Start Date* reverts to the Scale Ticket *Charge Start Date* originally entered. If not selected and the *Grace Period* is expired, the charge *Start Date* starts the day after the *Grace Period* ended.
- **Grace Period** – This is the number of days allowed before charges begin.
- **Days Per Cycle** – This represents the number of days the rate covers. If the rate is a daily rate, days per cycle equals 1. If the rate is a monthly rate, the days per cycle equals 30.

Charge Grid

- **Rate** – This is the rate to be charged alone or in addition to the initial rate.
- **Start Date** – This is the first date the rate is in effect.
- **End Date** – This is the last date the rate is in effect.
- **Inactive** – Unused Storage and Service Charge Schedules may be marked as inactive provided they are not set as a default schedule on Commodities or Locations. When Assembly Sheets and Settlements are being entered, only active schedules are available to select.
