Clear Browser Cache

When a web-based application gets an update, best practice is to clear the browser's cache. Below are instructions on how to clear browser cache on Google Chrome.

1. With Google Chrome open, press **F12** on the keyboard. The *Developer Tools* should appear at the bottom or side of the window.

Note: Developer Tools can also be opened by pressing Ctrl + Shift + I or right-clicking and choosing Inspect.

- 2. Minimize the Developer Tools window that opens, or move it to the side.
- 3. Right-click the **Refresh** button, and select *Empty Cache and Hard Reload*.



4. Close and reopen Google Chrome.
