

Assigning Grade Factors

Q. How to assign grade factors to all scale tickets associated with an assembly.

A. The Assign Grade Factor Result button looks for scale tickets associated with the assembly and will change the grade factor results to be the same on each scale ticket.

To reassign the grade factor results:

1. Click on the **Assign Grade Factor Result** button.

- All of the grade factors that are currently associated with the commodity will be listed.
- A grade factor that is not on a scale ticket can be chosen, but will not be applied to the scale ticket(s) that are not associated with this grade factor.
