

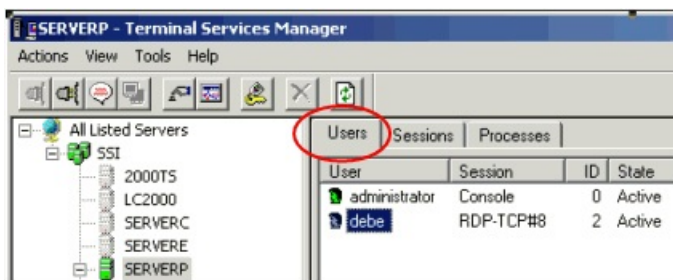
Logging Off Terminal Server Users

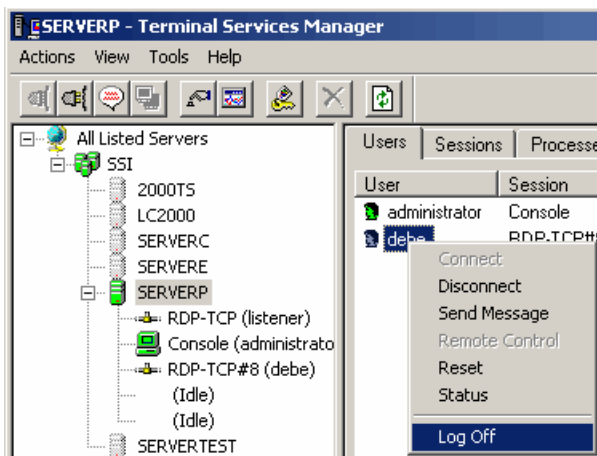
Sometimes an error message occurs at a WAN (Wide Area Network) location which forces you to log off a user from the Terminal Server.

Follow these instructions for logging off a user from Terminal Services:

1. Go to *Start / Settings / Control Panel*.
2. Double-click on *Administrative Tools*.
3. Double-click on *Terminal Services Manager*.
4. Go to the *Users* tab.



5. Right-click on the user you want to log off and highlight *Log Off* from the drop down menu.



6. Left-click on *Log Off* and the user will be logged off of their Terminal Services session.
