 In SKY Admin, select My John Deere Login to navigate to the login page and sign into My John Deere through SKY. This is available under the *Integrations Setup* area to enter a company-wide API Key and/or the *Location Preference Setup* to enter a Location-specific key.

Note: The Location key trumps the Company-level key when tying Vehicles to a Machine ID and when sending files.

- 5. Once the connection setup is completed within John Deere Operations Center, return to SKY Dispatch to continue connecting John Deere devices to Agvance Vehicles.
- 6. MyJD Monitors can be tied to Agvance Vehicles in the *Integrations Setup* grid under *Company Settings* in SKY Dispatch. The name defaults into the *Machine Alias* area but can be edited.
- 7. On the Jobs *List* or *Map* view, after selecting the Tickets, the *More Options* menu gives the ability to *Send Files* to *MyJohnDeere*. Indicate the *Device to send files to* from the drop-down, then drag and drop or select **browse** to locate the appropriate zip file.
